WHAT TO EXPECT:

LOTS OF FUN! Arrive at camp for check in between 4-6 p.m. Dinner is served at 6 p.m. Thursday evening: faculty chamber music concert. Friday: group classes, private lessons, chamber music, orchestra and a parent talent show in the evening. Saturday: group classes, private lessons, chamber music, orchestra, a student recital in the evening followed by the marshmallow roast. Sunday: orchestra and chamber music performances in the morning. Lunch is at noon and then you head home.

Recreational activities available at Seabeck include arts & crafts, swimming, boating, tennis, volleyball, soccer, ping-pong, and hiking. The conference center provides all of the essential services: meals, linens, bedding, soap, and towels. The lodging is “dorm-style.”

DIRECTIONS TO SEABECK

EDMONDS-KINGSTON FERRY

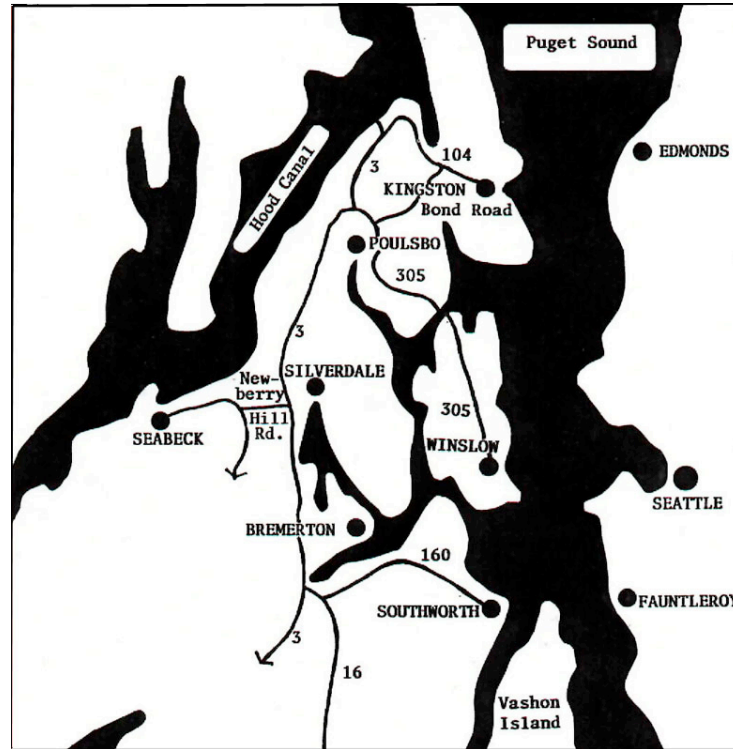
After departing the ferry follow Highway 104. Continue straight onto Bond Road (follow signs to Bremerton/Poulsbo). At the Bond Road-Highway 305 stoplight turn right onto Highway 305 and follow the signs to Highway 3 southbound. Exit Highway 3 at the Newberry Hill Road exit and turn Right onto Newberry Hill Road. When you come to a “T” in the road, turn right onto Seabeck Highway. Follow the signs to Seabeck Conference Center. (Estimated travel time from Kingston: 45 min)

SEATTLE-BREMERTON FERRY

After departing the ferry turn right on Warren Avenue, left on 6th Avenue, and continue on Kitsap Way. From Kitsap Way turn right onto Highway 3 northbound. Exit Highway 3 at the Newberry Hill Road exit and turn Left onto Newberry Hill Road. When you come to a “T” in the road, turn right onto Seabeck Highway. Follow the signs to Seabeck Conference Center. (Estimated travel time from Bremerton: 30 min)

SEATTLE-BAINBRIDGE ISLAND FERRY

After departing the ferry continue straight on Highway 305. Continue on Highway 305 off Bainbridge Island and through Poulsbo onto Highway 3 southbound. Exit Highway 3 at the Newberry Hill Road exit and turn Right onto Newberry Hill Road. When you come to a “T” in the road, turn right onto Seabeck Highway. Follow the signs to Seabeck Conference Center. (Estimated travel time from Bainbridge Island: 50 min)
